3. What does the word Joy, mean, biblically?

- a. Holman Bible Dictionary State of delight and well being that results from knowing and serving God...Joy is the fruit of a right relation with God. It is not something people can create by their own efforts. The Bible distinguishes joy from ______. The Greek word for pleasure is the word from which we get our word "hedonism," the philosophy of self-centered pleasure seeking. Paul referred to false teachers as "lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God" (2 Tim. 3:4 HCSB).
- b. **Deuteronomy 16:15** [ceremonial observance] 15 For seven days you shall keep the feast to the Lord your God at the place that the Lord will choose, because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you will be altogether joyful.
- c. **Psalm 16:11** -You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is ______ of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.
